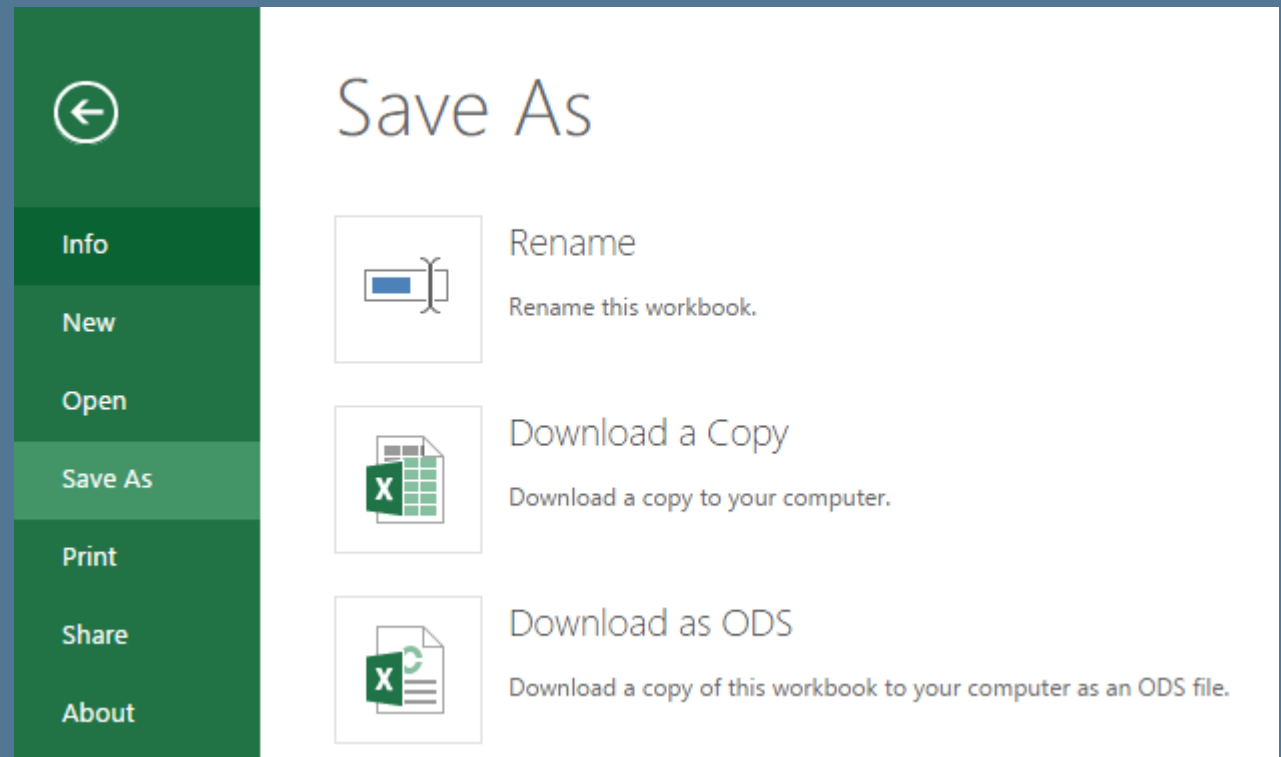

What's new in ODF since London 2014

What we've done since London

- ODF focus shifted towards online apps
 - Save as ODF enabled inside the Office 365 web clients and OneDrive
 - Documentation produced on using ODF as default format for Office 365 commercial customers ([here](#))
- Enabled import of ODF in Office on all mobile platforms
- Working on secret ODF project



Secret ODF PROJECT (FY16 work)

Like all upcoming work, this is an internal plan and subject to change

- Enable import of ODF documents for Word, Excel and PowerPoint on Mac desktop and iPad
- Enable export as ODF for Word, Excel, PowerPoint in:
 - Windows phone and tablet apps
 - Android
 - Mac desktop
 - iPad
 - iPhone
- Documents will be converted using our existing web conversion infrastructure, so these will behave as import/export rather than exposing ODF as a native file format in these apps

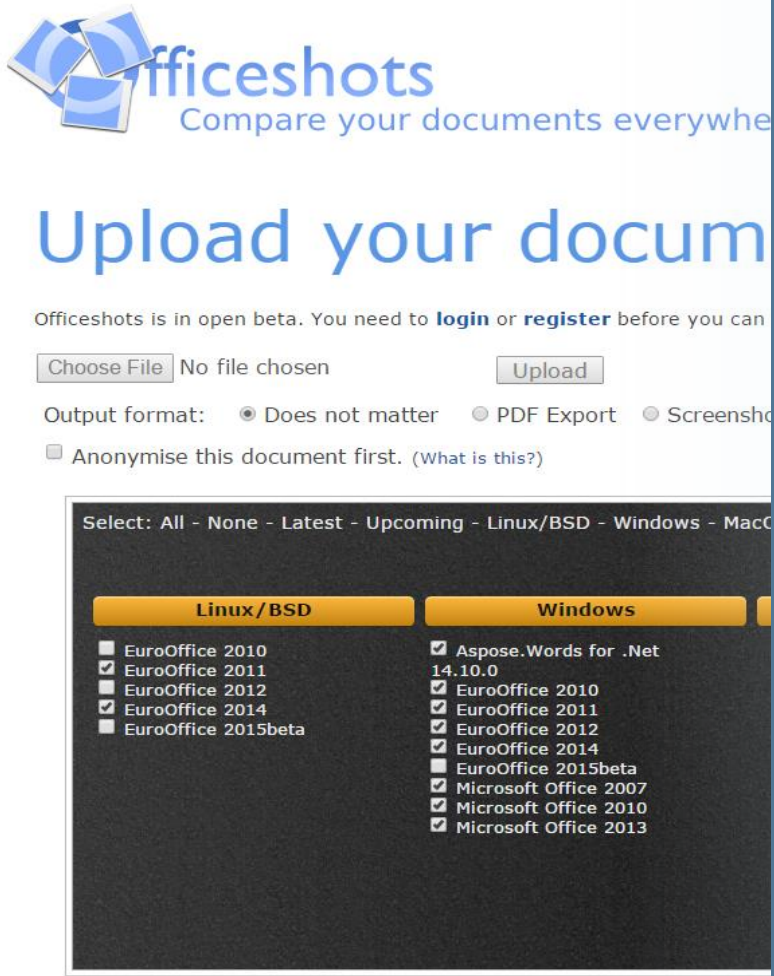

- Now we're expanding the product set beyond the Windows desktop

- As you all probably know...
 - OfficeShots round-trips ODF documents in various apps on server
 - Used extensively for interop testing during plugfests
- For the London plugfest we set up various Microsoft Office versions on some Azure VMs – officeshots.org
- For this plugfest...
 - We're creating a custom Office license to allow OfficeShots factories to run Office unattended and giving the Document Foundation 50 of them
 - We've created a VM running daily builds of Office 16, our in-development product
 - (Note that, like any other daily builds, this might have bugs in it)
